RESIDENT HALL WIRELESS ACCESS POINT INSTALLATION

The State of Oregon, acting by and through the State Board of Higher Education on behalf of Western Oregon University ("Owner") is accepting bids for a public improvement project at the Physical Plant Planning Office, 345 N. Monmouth Ave. Monmouth, OR or by email until 3:00 PM, Pacific Time, May 7, 2013 for the Resident Hall Wireless Access Point Installation project located on the campus of Western Oregon University, Monmouth, Oregon. The project includes the installation of approximately 200 wireless access points (devices provided by WOU; all cabling provided by contractor) in five existing residence halls. This work will include drilling through existing concrete, CMU and drywall framed walls, installing access panels, and the installation of inner ducts, as required.

Contractors need be Systimax certified installers.

A mandatory examination of the site and conditions will be conducted at 10:00 AM, Thursday, April 25, 2013. Bidders shall meet with Owner's Representative at the Physical Plant for that purpose. Attendance will be documented through a sign-in sheet prepared by the Owner's Representative. Prime bidders who arrive more than 5 minutes after start of time of the meeting (as stated in the solicitation and by the Owner's Representative's watch) or after the discussion portion of the meeting (whichever comes first) shall not be permitted to sign in and will not be permitted to submit a bid on the Project.

Bids will be opened and publicly read aloud on Tuesday, May 7, 2013 at 3:00 PM by the Owner's representative or designee.

Bids will be received on a lump-sum basis for all of the work. Bid packets available at the mandatory bid examination. Bids may be submitted by hand, mailed or emailed. No faxed bids will be accepted.

All bidders must comply with requirements of the prevailing wage law in ORS 279C.800 through ORS 279C.870, if applicable. All bidders must be registered with the Construction Contractor's Board at the time of bid submission. No bid will be considered unless fully completed in the manner provided in the "Instructions to Bidders" upon the Bid Form provided and accompanied by Bid Security. OUS encourages bids from Minority, Women, and Emerging Small Businesses.
