ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS/PROPOSALS

FURMAN HALL 4TH FLOOR RENOVATION

The State of Oregon, acting by and through the State Board of Higher Education on behalf of Oregon State University ("Owner") is accepting sealed bids and proposals for a public improvement project at Facilities Services, Oregon State University, 3015 SW Western Blvd., Corvallis, Oregon, until 2:00PM local time June 27, 2013 for the Furman Hall 4th Floor Renovation project located on the campus of Oregon State University, Corvallis, Oregon. The project includes the interior build-out of the existing 4th floor of Furman Hall, including but not limited to new enclosed offices on the 2nd & 3rd floors, interior exit signage, and miscellaneous exterior ADA upgrade handrail components.

A mandatory examination of the site and conditions will be made at 9:00AM, June 13, 2013. Bidders shall meet with the Owner's Representative on the 4th Floor of Education Hall, located at the intersection of 15th & Jefferson Way. Attendance will be documented through a sign-in sheet prepared by the Owner's Representative. Prime bidders who arrive more than 5 minutes after start time of the meeting (as stated in the solicitation and by the Owner's Authorized Representative's watch) or after the discussion portion of the meeting (whichever comes first) shall not be permitted to sign in and will not be permitted to submit a bid on the project.

As this is an RFP process, sealed bids will not be opened publicly.

Bids will be received on a lump-sum basis for all of the work. Bid packets may be obtained from Campus Operations, Oregon State University, 3015 SW Western Blvd., Corvallis, Oregon (phone number 541-737-9635) only upon deposit of \$150.00. Additional sets may be obtained for a non-refundable purchase price of \$75.00.

Bid packets may be examined at Campus Operations, as well as at the following locations: Daily Journal of Commerce Plan Center, Portland; Eugene Builders Exchange Corporation, Eugene; Salem Contractors Exchange, Salem; McGraw Hill Construction, Portland; Central Oregon Builders Exchange, Bend; Douglas County Plan Center, Roseburg; Willamette Valley Bid Center, Tangent; Contractor Plan Center, Clackamas, and Reed Construction Data.

All bidders must comply with requirements of the prevailing wage law in ORS 279C.800 through ORS 279C.870. All bidders must be registered with the Construction Contractor's Board at the time of bid submission. No bid will be considered unless fully completed in the manner provided in the "Instructions to Bidders" upon the Bid Form provided and accompanied by Bid Security. OUS encourages bids from Minority, Women, and Emerging Small Businesses.
