Included in the building will be research laboratories and supporting offices, teaching laboratories and studios, a University classroom, small classrooms, meeting spaces, administrative and faculty offices, student organization offices, building support facilities, and other spaces. The project will be constructed to LEED Silver equivalent standards and will be fully accessible.
