# Nash Hall RO System

The Oregon University System (OUS) is accepting sealed bids for a public improvement project at Procurement and Contract Services, Oregon State University, 644 SW 13<sup>th</sup> Street, Corvallis, Oregon, until 2:00 PM local time November 30, 2011 for the Nash Hall RO System Replacement project located on the campus of Oregon State University, Corvallis, Oregon. The project includes replacement of an existing reverse osmosis/DI system in the penthouse mechanical room of Nash Hall.

Bids will be received on a lump-sum basis for all of the work. Additional sets may be obtained for a non-refundable purchase price of \$25.00.
