Question from potential bidder: In section 1.1, second paragraph, it states that no control equipment is to be included as part of the bid, but later down in the RFP, it states that we need to be able to control existing displays, provide scheduling, and interface scoring, which would indicate that there is control equipment required. Which should we price?
 - University Response: This control equipment will be determined after we know what product we purchase, initially not needed as part of this bid proposal. There will be equipment needed as we determine how this all gets integrated, which will be the responsibility of the installer.
- 3. Question from potential bidder: If we in fact do have to control 4 existing displays, what display manufacture are they, and what type of input do they require?
