The project includes upgrades and renovations to the north half of the existing Whyte Track & Field Complex facility and grounds.

As a result of a prior RFQ, the Owner has pre-qualified three prime contractors to bid this project. **The prequalified firms will be the only prime contractors permitted to submit a bid to the Owner.** The contractors are: Andersen Construction, Emerick Construction and Fortis Construction.

A mandatory examination of the site and conditions will be made at **2 pm, Tuesday, October 18, 2016.** Bidders shall meet with the Owner's Representative at the west entrance to the track on the Oregon State University Campus, Corvallis, OR. Attendance will be documented through a sign-in sheet prepared by the Owner's Authorized Representative.

All bidders must comply with requirements of the prevailing wage law in ORS 279C.800 through ORS 279C.870. All bidders must be registered with the Construction Contractor's Board at the time of bid submission. No bid will be considered unless fully completed in the manner provided in the "Instructions to Bidders" upon the Bid Form provided. OSU encourages bids from Minority, Women, and Emerging Small Businesses.
