The project includes storm drain and asphalt pavement repairs in SW 30th Street, between SW Jefferson Way and SW Washington Way, on the Oregon State University Campus, Corvallis, Oregon.

A mandatory examination of the site and conditions will be made on Tuesday April 4, 2017 at 2:00PM. Bids will not be opened and publicly.

All bidders must comply with requirements of the prevailing wage law in ORS 279C.800 through ORS 279C.870. All bidders must be registered with the Construction Contractor's Board at the time of bid submission. No bid will be considered unless fully completed in the manner provided in the "Instructions to Bidders" upon the Bid Form provided and accompanied by Bid Security.
