Ouestions and Answers:

Item 1	 Q: "Valuation analysis" is referenced in #2. Is an opinion of value/USPAP-compliant appraisal report requested for the District land? A: No, OSU Cascades conducted an appraisal of the land at the time of purchase. OSU Cascades would like to better understand the value of the land from a development perspective.

Q: Would a proposal be responsive if a development feasibility analysis is proposed for only two or three high priority uses likely to be highest and best use?
A: Yes, if the response is persuasive enough to convince the working team, executive leadership or the Board of Trustees that no further analysis would be necessary.

Item 3 Q: Is there flexibility to suggest possible modifications to the project schedule outlined by the RFP?

A: Yes.
