**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**

Oregon State University (“Owner”) is accepting sealed bids for a public improvement project at Construction Contracts Administration, Oregon State University, 644 SW 13<sup>th</sup> Ave., Corvallis, Oregon, until **2:00PM** local time **January 24, 2019** for the **Campus Restroom ADA Upgrade** project located on the campus of Oregon State University, Corvallis, Oregon. The project includes ADA improvements for four campus buildings on Oregon State Universities Campus. Work includes the demolition, remodel, and expansion of existing restrooms within Gilbert, Covell and Nash Halls, along with the replacement of handrailing and replacement of a concrete site ramp at Langton Hall.

A mandatory examination of the site and conditions will be made at **Thursday January 3, 2019**. Bidders shall meet with the Owner's Representative at **Nash Hall 2820 SW Campus Way Corvallis, OR 97331 in Room 206 at 2:00PM**. Attendance will be documented through a sign-in sheet prepared by the Owner's Representative. Prime bidders who arrive more than 5 minutes after start time of the meeting (as stated in the solicitation and by the Owner's Authorized Representative's watch) or after the discussion portion of the meeting (whichever comes first) shall not be permitted to sign in and will not be permitted to submit a bid on the project.

Bids will be due **January 24, 2019 at 2:00PM**, local time, at the Property Services Building, 644 SW 13<sup>th</sup> Ave., Corvallis, Oregon by the Owner's representative or designee.

Bids will be received on a lump-sum basis for all of the work. Bid packets, plans and specifications shall be available for viewing and downloading at the OSU Online Planroom website, [www.osuplanroom.com](http://www.osuplanroom.com).

All bidders must comply with requirements of the prevailing wage law in ORS 279C.800 through ORS 279C.870. All bidders must be registered with the Construction Contractor's Board at the time of bid submission. No bid will be considered unless fully completed in the manner provided in the "Instructions to Bidders" upon the Bid Form provided. OSU encourages bids from Minority, Women, and Emerging Small Businesses.
