UHDS SECURITY CAMERA UPGRADE REBID

The Oregon University System (OUS) is accepting proposals for a public improvement project at Procurement and Contract Services, Oregon State University, 644 SW 13th Street, Corvallis, Oregon, until local time 2:00 PM Local Time, March 13, 2012 for the UHDS Security Camera Upgrade Rebid project located on the campus of Oregon State University, Corvallis, Oregon. The project includes the purchase and installation of new and the replacement of existing security cameras and mounting hardware in 13 University Housing & Dining Services (UHDS) buildings.

A mandatory examination of the site and conditions will be made at 1:00 PM Local Time, February 28, 2012. Proposers shall meet with the Owner's Representative in the Hawley Hall conference room (Room 116), located on Jefferson Way on the OSU campus. Attendance will be documented through a sign-in sheet prepared by the Owner's Authorized Representative. Prime Proposers who arrive more than 5 minutes after start time of the meeting (as stated in the solicitation and by the Owner's Authorized Representative's watch) or after the discussion portion of the meeting (whichever comes first) shall not be permitted to sign in and will not be permitted to submit a bid on the project.

As this is a RFP process, sealed Bids will not be opened publicly.

RFP documents may be obtained from Procurement and Contract Services, Oregon State University, 644 SW 13th Street, Corvallis, Oregon (phone number 541-737-9635) only upon deposit of \$75.00. Additional sets may be obtained for a non-refundable purchase price of \$40.00.

Deposits will be refunded for documents (including all addenda) returned in good, reusable condition (i.e. unmarked) within ten days after the Closing Date. For documents returned late, or in unusable condition, the deposit will be refunded less the purchase price.

RFP documents may be examined at Procurement and Contract Services, as well as at the following locations: Daily Journal of Commerce Plan Center, Portland; Eugene Builders Exchange Corporation, Eugene; Salem Contractors Exchange, Salem; McGraw Hill Construction, Portland; Central Oregon Builders Exchange, Bend; Douglas County Plan Center, Roseburg; Willamette Valley Bid Center, Tangent; Contractor Plan Center, Clackamas, and Reed Construction Data.

All Proposers must comply with requirements of the prevailing wage law in ORS 279C.800 through ORS 279C.870. All Proposers must be registered with the Construction Contractor's Board at the time of bid/proposal submission. No proposal will be considered unless fully completed in the manner provided in the "Instructions to Bidders" upon the Bid Form provided and accompanied by Bid Security. OUS encourages bids from Minority, Women, and Emerging Small Businesses.
