QUESTION/ANSWER

Item 2 Q: Can we perform a full-depth PJP in lieu of CJP for detail 3/S601. AISC shop is concerned about testing?

A: No, a PJP weld in lieu of CJP weld is not acceptable

CLARIFICATION:

Item 3 Delineation of Asbestos abatement scope and responsibilities as described in the Pre-Bid conference and in the project manual were found to be contradictory. Please include the cost for abatement of roofing materials in your Base Bid as depicted in the construction documents and in reference to the hazardous material report provided.

Phasing Approach and Preliminary Project Schedule (35 points)

Describe your firm's approach to the programming of on-site construction activities for this Project. Elaborate on any strategic phasing between major elements of construction and between individual roof tops. If an extended schedule is proposed, it is the general contractor's responsibility to ensure the building remains weather-tight during periods of no construction.

Provide a proposed Preliminary Project schedule that identifies milestones and duration for each proposed activity.

To ensure best value for the building and university, OSU seeks to determine the best overall approach to roofing demolition and abatement; whether that is a separate contract carried by ownership or included in the base bid and managed by the GC. Please include a brief written description to communicate possible implications of this scope on overall schedule and logistics.
