We don't see an Approach section Is there an existing section where you'd like us to include this type of information? Are you planning on adding an RFP section focused on approach?

A: Sub-Section 7.8.2 of the original RFP has been replaced with the following:

7.8.2 Experience with Similar Efforts and Approach (30 Points)

Prototypical design will be a key element to the development of the UHDS Vision. Explain your team's previous experience helping a university client program and layout a residence prototype that can be successfully repeated with efficiency and flexibility while adjusting the building

character to respond to the site and dwelling type.

Explain your team's previous experience with design and construction of higher education living environments of similar size and budget as defined in this RFP. Highlight the proposed project team members who participated in the project examples.

Explain your team's previous experience in the design and construction of inclusive student spaces that meet the needs of a diverse population.

Describe your team's experience understanding, accommodating, and prioritizing needs and requirements of residents, students, staff and visitors with disabilities.

Taking your team's previous experience into account, please describe how you would approach Phase 1 of our project.
