9.6 Apprenticeship Requirements

9.6.1 The Offeror will be required to employ apprentices (as that term is defined in ORS 660.010) to perform twelve percent (12%) or more of the work hours that workers in apprenticeable occupations (as that term is defined in ORS 660.010) perform; and (ii) require in each subcontract with a value of \$750,000 or more that the Subcontractor employ apprentices to perform twelve percent (12%) or more of the work hours that workers in apprenticeable occupations perform on the subcontract. Any additional apprenticeship requirements may be provided in the Sample Contract.
